

ORDINANCE No. 189014

Authorize contract with CDM Smith Inc. to provide engineering services for the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant Headworks Screening Improvements Project No. E10805, in the amount of \$3,286,837 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) operates the Columbia Boulevard Wastewater Treatment Plant (CBWTP) to provide wastewater treatment for the City of Portland, in accordance with State of Oregon Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) issued NPDES (National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System) permit requirements.
2. BES requires professional consulting engineering services for predesign, design, and support services during construction for the CBWTP Headworks Screening Improvements project.
3. Using the consultant selection procedures established in the Professional, Technical and Expert (PTE) Services Manual per Chapter 5.68 of the Code of the City of Portland, the selection committee selected CDM Smith Inc. for award of the PTE contract.
4. The established cost for the PTE contract is \$3,286,837 with M/W/ESB participation of \$1,117,791 or 34% of the total contract amount. The Confidence Level Rating Index for the PTE contract is "Optimal." Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2018-19 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10805

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract with CDM Smith Inc. for the purposes described in Section 1, in the amount of \$3,286,837.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


