ORDINANCE No. 189018

*Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder and provide for payment for the City Hall Exterior Restoration project for an estimated \$3,833,899 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. OMF-Facilities is responsible for restoring the exterior of City Hall.
- 2. OMF-Facilities seeks Council's authorization for Procurement Services to issue a competitive solicitation and execute a contract for the City Hall Exterior Restoration Project.
- 3. Project includes cleaning and restoration of the exterior façade, windows and doors, roof replacement, new eco-roof and replacement of roof top mechanical equipment.
- 4. The engineer's estimate for this contract action is \$3,833,899.
- 5. The Bureau's confidence level in the estimated cost is optimal.
- 6. Funding of \$3,833,899 is available in the Facilities major maintenance reserve and will be appropriated in the FY 2018-19 budget.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer to facilitate the use of the competitive solicitation process in accordance with City Code for the purchase of construction services for the City Hall Restoration project.
- b. Upon Council acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's Report recommending the contract award, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.
- c. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the City Hall major maintenance reserves when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists to prevent delays in proceeding with the project. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
