Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of this legislation would be to authorize an increase of \$7,500,000 to the contract's not to exceed amount, for land line and data transport services for City bureaus. This will extend the contract originally put in place five years ago, and renewed two years ago. This contract shall not be extended beyond five additional years, for a maximum total term of 10 years.
