* Ratify a Letter of Agreement with the District Council of Trade Unions to authorize a 4% wage increase to each step of the Water Bureau Operating Engineer III Classification (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Operating Engineers Local 701 (Union) is a signatory to the collective bargaining agreement (CBA) between the City and the District Council of Trade Unions effective July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2020.
- 2. The Union is the sole and exclusive bargaining agent for Operating Engineers employed by the Water Bureau (Bureau).
- 3. The Bureau is requiring changes to the Operating Engineer Classifications to better meet the needs of the Bureau.
- 4. These changes reflect a higher level of responsibility for the Operating Engineer III.
- 5. The parties of this agreement have agreed to a four percent (4%) wage increase to each step of the Operating Engineer III classification, removal of the three percent (3%) certification premium pay for hours worked, and lowering the Level four (4) certification pay from four percent (4%) to three percent (3%)

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The LOA between the City and Operating Engineers, Local 701 attached as Exhibit A is hereby ratified by Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay would unnecessarily delay the orderly implementation of the provisions of this letter of agreement; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage by the Council.
