## **ORDINANCE NO.** 189044

\*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Gresham for \$931,905 for the HOME Investment Partnership Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

- 1. In accordance with the HOME Consortium Agreement No. 30006376, a portion of the U.S. Housing and Urban Development HOME grant is attributable to Gresham's participation in the Consortium, and Gresham is entitled to plan for the expenditure of such funds.
- 2. There is a total of \$931,905 in HOME funds available to Gresham in the Portland Housing Bureau budget, comprised of \$700,575 in FY 2018-19 Gresham HOME funds, \$211,330 in FY 2017-18 carryover funds, and \$20,000 in Program Income.
- 3. The City of Gresham will implement a portion of the HOME Program in the amount of \$900,379. The balance of Gresham's HOME Program funding, \$31,526, will be administered by the City of Portland.
- 4. Funds for this agreement are available in the approved FY 2018-19 Budget for HOME funds.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Portland Housing Bureau Director and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with City of Gresham for the City of Gresham's HOME Investment Partnership Program in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the program funds must be obligated within required timeframes; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
