

ORDINANCE NO. 189044

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Gresham for \$931,905 for the HOME Investment Partnership Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

SECTION 1. The Council finds that:

1. In accordance with the HOME Consortium Agreement No. 30006376, a portion of the U.S. Housing and Urban Development HOME grant is attributable to Gresham's participation in the Consortium, and Gresham is entitled to plan for the expenditure of such funds.
2. There is a total of \$931,905 in HOME funds available to Gresham in the Portland Housing Bureau budget, comprised of \$700,575 in FY 2018-19 Gresham HOME funds, \$211,330 in FY 2017-18 carryover funds, and \$20,000 in Program Income.
3. The City of Gresham will implement a portion of the HOME Program in the amount of \$900,379. The balance of Gresham's HOME Program funding, \$31,526, will be administered by the City of Portland.
4. Funds for this agreement are available in the approved FY 2018-19 Budget for HOME funds.


NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Portland Housing Bureau Director and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with City of Gresham for the City of Gresham's HOME Investment Partnership Program in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the program funds must be obligated within required timeframes; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


