

## ORDINANCE No. 189045

\*Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement Multnomah County and the City of Gresham to receive \$3,500 and \$10,000 respectively, for production of updates to the five-year Consolidated Plan fiscal years 2016-2020, Annual Action Plans fiscal years 2018-2020, Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing, updates and other plans and performance reports as requested of the Consortium by U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires entitlement jurisdictions to submit a five-year Consolidated Plan, one-year Action Plans and an Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing report.
2. The City of Portland (City) is designated the coordinator of the preparation and amendment of the Consortium's multi-year Consolidated Plans, annual Action Plans, Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing, and Citizen Participation Plan. Multnomah County (County) and City of Gresham (Gresham) compensate the City for this service.
3. County and Gresham again desire to enter into agreements with the City, for the Action Plan FY 2018-2019, five-year Consolidated Plan, the Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing, updates and other plans and performance reports as requested of the Consortium by HUD.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Bureau Director and City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the County and Gresham, substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibits A and Exhibit B respectively.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to receive annual payment from the County in the amount of \$3,500 and from Gresham in the amount of \$10,000.


