

## ORDINANCE No. 189046

\* Amend a grant agreement with El Programa Hispano Catolico Proyecto UNICA, a subsidiary of Catholic Charities, to provide Spanish-speaking/Latina specific navigator services at the Gateway Center for Domestic Violence Services and administer client assistance funds for all participants at the Center up to \$5,000 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32000391)

The City of Portland ordains:

### Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Pursuant to the Invitation to Submit a Request for Grant circulated publicly on or about April 15, 2010, City sought to provide grants to fund domestic violence victim-centered and culturally specific navigator/ advocacy services on site at the Gateway Center for Domestic Violence Services ("the Center"), located at 10305 E. Burnside Street, in Portland, Oregon.
2. Portland City Council, through City Ordinance No. 183785, authorized a grant agreement with Grantee after Grantee was selected for a grant award based on its response to an invitation to provide Latina-specific navigator/ advocacy services at the Gateway Center for Domestic Violence Services.
3. The resulting Grant Agreement No. 32000391 was executed on or about June 1, 2010. The effective date of the Grant Agreement was June 1, 2010 to May 31, 2013.
4. Portland City Council, through City Ordinance No. 185323, amended the original grant agreement, to extend funding for navigator services through June 30, 2014, and client assistance monies through June 30, 2015.
5. Portland City Council, through City Ordinance No. 186683, amended the agreement again to extend navigator services through June 30, 2015.
6. Portland City Council, through City Ordinance No. 187330, amended the agreement again to extend navigator services through June 30, 2017.
7. Portland City Council, through City Ordinance No. 188472, amended the agreement again to extend navigator services through June 30, 2018. The current Amendment expires June 30, 2018.
8. Among other services, EPH UNICA administers a client assistance fund for Gateway Center participants in the amount of \$19,000. EPH UNICA charges an annual \$1000 administration fee for the client assistance funds.

9. Requests for service have increased at the Gateway Center, and the need for client assistance has consequently increased. Accordingly, more funds are needed to fairly and adequately administer client-assistance payments to Latina survivors of domestic violence.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Affairs is authorized to sign the grant agreement with El Programa Hispano Catolico Proyecto UNICA, a subsidiary of Catholic Charities, in substantial conformance with the one attached as Exhibit A and approved as to form by the City Attorney.
- b. The grant funding for client assistance (up to \$5,000) will be from the Center's ongoing operational funding.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because delay in proceeding with this agreement will unnecessarily delay the processing of payment to victims and thereby deny victims and their children timely access to the expanded services to be provided at the Gateway Center for Domestic Violence Services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
