ORDINANCE No. 189055

Amend fee schedule for the Office of Neighborhood Involvement (Ordinance; amend Enb-5.02)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Office of Neighborhood Involvement Noise Program manages the City's noise regulations and educates the community about the benefits of the sounds of the City while permitting vibrant events and construction within Portland communities.
- The fees charged by the Office of Neighborhood Involvement partially fund the Noise Program but are not intended to provide full cost recovery for the critical service of enforcing Title 18 Noise Regulations.
- 3. The fees provided in Exhibit A include a 5% increase to the Noise fees.
- 4. The Noise Review Board, which is composed of community and industry representatives, reviewed and supported the fee changes referenced in this ordinance.
- 5. The changes to the fees provided in Exhibit A are required to reach the budgetary goals for Fiscal Year 2018-19.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Fee Schedule attached as Exhibit A to this ordinance shall be effective August 1, 2018.
- b. Exhibit A to this ordinance is adopted as binding City policy.
