Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of the legislation is as follows:

- 1. To reappoint Commissioner Saltzman as the City's elected representative on the Allocation Committee of the Children's Levy until his term as a City Council member expires on December 31, 2018:
- 2. Appoint Mayor Wheeler as the City's elected representative on the Allocation Committee of the Children's Levy beginning January 1, 2019 and expiring June 30, 2020; and
- 3. Reappoint Julie S. Young as the City's community representative on the Committee.

The Act authorizing the Children's Levy adopted by City Council requires that a 5-member Allocation Committee be composed of an elected representative from the Portland City Council, an elected representative from the Multnomah County Board of Commissioners, two community representatives appointed by the City Council and County Board respectively, and a representative of the business community chosen by the Mayor. The Allocation Committee is the governing board for the Portland Children's Levy.

None. The Allocation Committee bylaws prescribe the composition of the Allocation Committee and vacancies are filled using the processes prescribed by the appointing entity. City-appointed community members of the Allocation Committee apply for membership on the Committee via the city application process for board and commission appointments.
