ORDINANCE No. 189063

*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the St Johns Truck Strategy, Phase II project, total project cost is \$4,143,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The St Johns Truck Strategy, Phase II project implements the St Johns Truck Strategy, adopted as a report to City Council in May of 2001
- 2. In 2016, the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) entered into a \$3,002,357 funding intergovernmental agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation through a federal grant to design and construct the project (Ordinance 187653).
- 3. Additional funding for the project comes from the PBOT's Transportation System Development Charge Program, \$1,4400,000.
- 4. Project design is completed and now PBOT is proceeding with bidding the project for construction.
- 5. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 17/18 and FY 18/19 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
- The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is moderate; as plans, specifications, and estimates are now completed and the project is ready for bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Office is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00453 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
