Ordinance No. 22268

An Ordinance vacating a portion of Sixteenth Street.

WHEREAS due notice was given by advertisement thereof for four successive weeks, to-wit from the 11th day of July 1916 to the 11th day of August 1916 both dates inclusive, in the Daily Bulletin the City Official newspaper published in the City of Portland, that at a regular meeting of the Council of said City of Portland to be held on the 16th day of August 1916, at 10:00 o'clock, a.m. a petition would be presented to said Council praying for the vacation of all of that part of Sixteenth Street in the City of Portland, County of Malthomah State of Oregon more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

The East Ten (10°) feet of Sixteenth Street between the south line of Montgomery Street and a line One Hundred (100°) feet south of and parallel to the south line of Hall Street excepting the portions of said East Ten (10°) feet lying in Harrison Street, Heights Terrace and Hall Street;

also the West Ten (10°) feet of Sixteenth Street, between the south line of Montgomery Street and a line One Hundred (100°) feet south of and parallel to the south line of Hall Street, excepting the portions of said West Ten (10°) feet lying in Heights Terrace and Hall Street, thereby making said Sixteenth Street Sixty (60°) feet in width

which said notics, together with due proof of its publication was filed in the office of the Auditor of The City of Portaland on the 12th day of August 1916, prior to the presentation of said petition to the Council, and

for the vacation of said portion of Sixteenth Street was duly presented to the Council on the date named in said notice, to-wit on the 16th day of August 1916, which said petition duly set forth a description of that portion of Sixteenth Street proposed and sought to be vacated and the reasons of such vacation and the purpose for which the ground is proposed to be used, and was duly signed by numerous persons owning property shutting upon said Sixteenth Street and interested in and desiring the vacation of that part of Sixteenth Street herein described, and

whereas, there was appended to said petition as a part thereof, and as a basis for each vacation, and as a basis for the granting of the preyer of said petition, the consent of the owners in the simple of at least two-

thirds of the real estate fronting on both sides of said street part of which is proposed to be vacated, estimated upon the frontage of said street, said frontage commencing at a line drawn equi-distant from the termini of the portion of the street proposed to be vacated, and extending along said proposed vacation the entire length thereof side Two Hundred (2001) feet in each direction from the termini thereof, which said consent of owners is in writing and duly acknowledged before an officer authorized to take acknowledgements, and is attached to said petition and filed therewith, with the Auditor of the City of Portland and

WHEREAS, the Council upon the presentation of said petition and the filing of proof of publication of the notice thereof, did fix a meeting of said Council to be held on the 25th day of August, 1916 at 10:00 c clock a.m. as the time for hearing said petition and any objectics which might be filed thereto if any there be, and

WHEREAS at the said time fixed by the Council for hearing said petition and any objections which might be filed thereto, said petition was duly considered by the Council, and the Council did Escertain and determine at that time and does now hereby escertain determine and find that all the foregoing recited facts are true and that all the acts and things above recited have been done as required by the Charter of the City of Portland, and that the consent of the owners in fee simple of at least two thirds of the real estate fronting on both sides of said sureet part of which is proposed to be vacated estimated upon the frontage of said street, said frontage commencing at a line drawn equi-distant from the termini of the portion of the street proposed to be vacated and extending along such proposed vacation the entire length thereof and Two Hundred (200°) feet in each direction from the termini thereof had been obtained in writing and duly acknowledged before an officer authorized to take acknowledgments, and was attached to and filed with seld petition, and that no objections to the vacation of said portion of said street had or have been made or filed, and that the public interest will not be prejudiced by the vacation of said portion of said Sixteenth Street and

WHEREAS the Council did grant the prayer of said petition in its entirety and does hereby cause said action and said findings to be made a matter of record now there?cre

The City of Portland Does Ordain as Follows;

Section 1. The Council of The City of Portland hereby finds and determines that all of the facts hereinabove resited are true; that all of the sets and things above

recited have been done and performed as herein set forth. and as required by the Charter of The City of Portland. The Council finds and determines that the owners of at least two-thirds of the real astate fronting upon both sides of the said street, part of which is proposed to be vacated, estimated upon the frontage of the street. said frontage commencing at a line drawn equi-distant from the termini of the portion of the street proposed to be vacated, and extending along such proposed vacation the entire length thereof and Two Hundred (2001) fest in each direction from the termini thereof, have given their consent, which said consent of owners is in writing and duly acknowledged before an officer authorized to take acknowledgments, and is and was attached to said petition and filed therewith with the Auditor of the City of Portland. The Council further determines and finds that no objection or objections to the vacation of said portion of said street had or have been made or filed, and that the public interest will not be prejudiced by the vacation of the portion of said Sixteenth Street herein described.

Section 2. That all of the following described pertian of Sixteenth Street in the City of Portland, County of Multnomah, State of Oregon, be and hereby is vacated, to-wit:

The East Ten (10') feet of Sixteenth Street between the south line of Montgomery Street and a line One Hundred (100') feet south of and parallel to the south line of Hall Street, excepting the portions of said East Ten (10') feet lying in Harrison Street, Heights Terrace and Hall Street

Also the West Ten (10') feet of Sixteenth Street, between the south line of Montgomery Street and a line One Hundred (100') feet south of and parallel to the south line of Hall Street, excepting the portions of said West Ten (10') feet lying in Heights Terrace and Hall Street, thereby making said Sixteenth Street Sixty (60') feet in width;

and the vacation of said described portion of Sixteenth Street is hereby made a matter of record.
