Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the Marine Drive Path: NE 112th Ave – 185th Ave Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Marine Drive Trail is a significant component of Portland's 40-mile Loop, which 1. Portland, Multnomah County, and Gresham resolved to build in 1985. It is also featured in the regional Greenspaces Master Plan adopted by Metro in 1990.
- 2. The Portland Bureau of Parks and Recreation applied for a Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality (CMAQ) Grant in the amount of \$966,000 on September of 2011 for the Marine Drive Path: NE 112th Ave – 185th Ave Sec. project.
- 3. Funding has been included in the Portland Bureau of Transportation's FY 18-19 budget.
- The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is optimal; PBOT has completed the project design and it is ready to go out to bid as soon as this ordinance is approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report a. recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Office is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to PBOT T00024 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
