ORDINANCE NO. 189094

Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement in the amount of \$20,000 with Clackamas County for the activation of the Clackamas County Emergency Notification System (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The City of Portland Water Bureau coordinates plans and emergency operations to minimize the impact of incidents or disasters. The Water Bureau works with public and private sector partners to ensure a coordinated community response. These partnerships help the public be better prepared in the event of a large-scale emergency or disaster.
- 2. The Clackamas County Department of Disaster Management works with public and private sector partners to ensure a coordinated community response during emergency events and has an Emergency Notification System.
- 3. This legislation will authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement between Clackamas County Department of Disaster Management and the Water Bureau that will provide the basis for a cooperative working relationship for the activation of the Clackamas County Emergency Notification System at the request of the Water Bureau.
- 4. The Emergency Notification System will be used as a life-safety emergency notifications to their customers; pre-loading of Water Bureau dam inundation notification templates; updating and development of a pre-recorded message on an as needed basis; uploading contact information and wireless emergency alerts; and for providing activation reports and summaries.
- 5. The Water Bureau will compensate Clackamas County annually for an administrative fee of \$2,000 per year. The term of the Intergovernmental Agreement will be ten years. The not to exceed amount of the Agreement is \$20,000.
- 6. Funding in the amount of \$2,000 is available in the Water Bureau FY 2018-19 Budget. Additional funds will be requested in the FY 2019-20 through FY 2027-28 Budgets.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Water Bureau Administrator is authorized to execute on behalf of the City an Intergovernmental Agreement with Clackamas County for a cooperative working relationship for the activation of the Clackamas County Emergency Notification System in a form substantially in accordance with the attached as Exhibit A.

- b. Amendments increasing the total compensation to the Intergovernmental Agreement may be agreed to and executed by the Portland Water Bureau Administrator up to twenty-five percent of the total Agreement amount. Any increase exceeding twentyfive percent of the total compensation would need City Council approval.
- c. That the Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Water Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
