## 189095 **ORDINANCE** No.

\*Authorize a \$4,512,415 five-year contract with a five-year option with CSDC Inc. to continue implementation of the initial phase of the AMANDA upgrade and continued maintenance and support of the computerized permit tracking system for Bureau of Development Services (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- On March 18, 2009, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 182607 authorizing Contract 1. 31000013 with CSDC Systems, Inc. for maintenance and technical support services for the AMANDA permitting and case management system.
- 2. On December 30, 2016, Contract 31000013 was renumbered as 30005953 following the acquisition of CSDC Systems, Inc. by CSDC Inc.
- 3. Contract 30005953 will expire on August 31, 2018.
- 4. CSDC's AMANDA Software is the backbone of the BDS permit system. Other software is also integrated into the system. AMANDA Software is used extensively by other City bureaus as well as BDS.
- The new contract with CSDC shall be effective from September 1, 2018 to August 31, 2023 5. with total costs not to exceed \$4,512,415 and will cover implementation of the AMANDA upgrade and continued maintenance, modification and enhancement of the AMANDA software. The contract contains a 5-year option, for a total of 10 years.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute a contract with CSDC, Inc. for software and related services for an initial term of five years, with a 5-year option, and an initial term amount not to exceed \$4,512,415, provided such contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's Office.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in proceeding with the amendment will hamper the City's ability to proceed with the Portland Online Permitting System project as planned and prohibit designating payment to CSDC Inc. in a timely manner; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
