ORDINANCE No. 189096

*Pay bodily injury lawsuit of Colin Christopher and Emily Furstenau in the sum of \$225,000 involving the Portland Bureau of Transportation (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Colin Christopher and his wife Emily Fuerstenau, through their attorneys Michael Wise and David Penoyer, have filed a bodily injury lawsuit against the City for damages suffered in a vehicle collision between two non-City drivers on July 22, 2014. The complaint identified \$17.5 million in damages.
- 2. The lawsuit was investigated by Risk Management Services and the City Attorney's Office. The investigation indicated that there was a substantial risk that the City could be found liable. Therefore, to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the lawsuit at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services and the City Attorney's Office recommend the lawsuit be compromised for the total sum of \$225,000. The City Attorney's Office and Risk Management are authorized to enter into a formal Settlement Agreement and Release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney, and plaintiffs and their attorneys will fully execute this document in exchange for the City's payment.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check in the amount of \$225,000 made payable to Schwabe Williamson & Wyatt Client Trust Account.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this bodily injury lawsuit; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
