ORDINANCE No. 189098

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for services related to the I-84 Sullivan's Gulch Pedestrian/Bike Bridge for an amount not to exceed \$75,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Transportation is designing and constructing a pedestrian and bicycle bridge across I-84 and Sullivan's Gulch.
- The Oregon Department of Transportation is responsible for the maintenance and operation of Interstate 84 and must review construction and traffic control plans.
- 3. This agreement will provide for the Oregon Department of Transportation to invoice the Bureau of Transportation for staff time assisting the project.
- 4. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project for the agencies review is moderate, the estimate was prepared by the agency.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to approve an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for the I-84 Sullivan's Gulch Bicycle and Pedestrian Bridge in a form substantially similar.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the assistance of the Oregon Department of Transportation is necessary to continue to advance the design therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
