ORDINANCE No. 189100

*Initiate foreclosure action on four properties for the collection of delinquent City liens placed against the properties (Ordinance)

The City of Portland Ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Portland City Code Chapter 5.30 establishes a process for foreclosing delinquent liens on properties. The foreclosure process is generally used as a last resort, after repeated code violation fines and liens have gone unpaid.
- 2. Portland City Code section 5.30.100 requires the Auditor's Office to prepare a proposed foreclosure list and submit the list to the City Council for action.
- 3. The Bureau of Development Services submitted 10 properties it identified as priority Vacant and Distressed Properties to the Auditor's Office for foreclosure consideration. Out of the 10 properties, the Auditor's Office removed six because they did not fulfill the requirements for foreclosure: three of the properties are being foreclosed by jurisdictions or mortgagees outside of the City of Portland's government organization, two properties are still being evaluated, and one property is occupied.
- 4. The Auditor's Office has reviewed the case files of the four remaining properties, and has determined that the properties meet the foreclosure requirements and should be included on the proposed foreclosure list based on their potential to help solve public health, safety, or welfare objectives, per Portland City Code section 5.30.100. Additional consideration was given to the number of abatements on a property, whether the owner had multiple delinquencies and the negative impact the property has had on the neighborhood.
- 5. The Auditor's Office mailed notices to the property owners, by certified mail with return-receipts required, of pending foreclosure action between March 16 and May 31, 2018, as required by Portland City Code section 5.30.050(D).

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The City Council approves Foreclosure List 2018-02, attached as Exhibit A, and directs the City Treasurer to begin foreclosure proceedings to sell the following properties:
 - 1. 544 SE 137th Ave., OREGON STATE OF(DVA), CP: YEE, NORMAN 19390576, owners of record. Tax no. R293001150.

- 2. 5616 N Harvard St., YEE, NORMAN, owner of record. Tax No. R669905600
- 8516 N Calhoun Ave., YEE, NORMAN 18900564, owner of record. Tax No. R073800040
- 4. 4725 NE 22nd Ave., OREGON STATE OF(DVA), CP: YEE, NORMAN 19251801, owners of record. Tax No. R860711100
- b. The City Council accepts the Foreclosure Reports, attached as Exhibits B-1, B-2, B-3, and B-4.
- c. As provided by Portland City Code section 5.30.210, the owner or any person having a recorded interest in a property included on Foreclosure List 2018-02, or their legal representative, may redeem the property by paying the redemption price to the City Treasurer at any time within one year from the date of the foreclosure sale.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists for the City to perform its sale auction prior to Multnomah County's initiation of its foreclosure; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
