Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The City has an interest in developing community resiliency in the face of natural and manmade disasters and will collaborate with PGE and PSU to test the utility of a PREPHub to achieve emergency preparedness goals. PREPHubs are disaster resilience nodes are composed of technological services that a community may use in both every-day and emergency situations, such as radio communications, public Wi-Fi, cached goods, lights and etc.

The Portland Bureau of Emergency Management (PBEM) will fulfill the City's responsibilities outlined in the Cooperative Agreement on the City's behalf.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

This agreement records the practice of cooperation among City, PGE and PSU staff in the course of their normal work. PBEM will contribute 90,000 to the PREPHub Pilot Project.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This agreement tests the feasibility of PREPHubs in the Portland Metro Area to see if they will increase community resilience. The pilot project does not have a specific demographic focus.
