* Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for Right of Way Services for the North Rivergate Freight Project for \$5,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Council approved an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Port of Portland and the City of Portland for the North Rivergate Freight Project.
- 2. This agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation will provide for Right of Way Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


