### Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The purpose of this legislation is for City Council to authorize an agreement with Portland Fire Fighters Association (PFFA) to settle grievances and revise the City's reprimand policy.

This agreement will settle six grievances. The City and PFFA agree that it is in their mutual interests to resolve the grievances without further litigation. Under the current 2016-2019 collective bargaining agreement, oral and written reprimands must remain on an employee's personnel file permanently. This agreement will revise the policy to allow removal of reprimands after one or three years.
