Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

- This action will add ODOT grant funding and Parks SDC funding to allow construction.
- This is the 1st grant amendment.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

- Long-term financial impacts for the City include costs of \$7,235 per year for operations and maintenance of this trail. Higher use and an increased need for operations and maintenance will occur on adjacent existing trail improvements as a result of the new trail.
- Budget impacts does the action amend the budget yes; This will add \$344,364 in federal grant funds passed through ODOT. See the Budgetary Impact Worksheet for additional information.
- The legislation authorizes acceptance of additional federal funds that require \$35,366 in local match and \$120,000 in ODOT required over match funds to insure bid award. These funds will come from Parks SDC.
- The expense is a project estimate, with a high level of confidence.
- Current and future staffing levels will not change from current staff levels. Approximately 69 hours per year of staff time will be needed for this legislation. Since there are adjacent existing trail facilities there are no demographic impacts of changes in staffing.
- Financial agreements the legislation result in a modified financial obligation and benefit, including IGA amendment.

Community impacts and community involvement:

- This project has strong support and the Citizens of Portland will benefit from having this bicycle and pedestrian trail that provides a vital link in connecting the Springwater Corridor as a recreational and alternative transportation corridor.
- Planning for the trail involved numerous public involvement opportunities, including
 presentations to community groups, workshops, site tours, for the Sellwood Moreland
 Improvement League (SMILE), Sellwood Natural Area Stewardship Committee, 40 Mile Loop
 Organization and private citizens. A web page was developed for the project on Portland Parks
 site.
