## ORDINANCE No. 189132

Authorize a contract with Brown and Caldwell, Inc. for professional services for the Inverness Pump Station 24-inch Pressure Line Rehabilitation Project No. E10887 for \$1,100,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

- Section 1. The Council finds:
  - 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) is in need of a consulting engineering firm to provide professional engineering services for the Inverness Pump Station 24-inch Pressure Line Rehabilitation, Project No. E10887.
  - 2. Consultant selection has been conducted in accordance with Chapter 5.68 of the Code of the City of Portland (RFP 00000551). The consultant selection committee recommends that Brown and Caldwell, Inc. be retained to provide the required professional engineering services.
  - 3. The established cost is estimated not to exceed \$1,100,000 with M/W/ESB participation of approximately \$220,000 or 20%. The Confidence Level Rating Index for the PTE contract is "Optimal". Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2018-FY 2019 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10887.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to enter into a contract with Brown and Caldwell, Inc. for services described above, in a form similar to the agreement added as Exhibit A, in an amount not-to-exceed \$1,100,000.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
