

ORDINANCE No. 189133

Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder for construction of the Downtown-Old Town: Caruthers-Mill Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10986 in the amount of \$3,296,200 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to rehabilitate 7,300 feet of sanitary sewer pipe primarily in the Portland State University area that is in severely deteriorated condition.
2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe, including manholes and service laterals.
3. The engineer's estimate for the contract action is \$3,296,200. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2018-19 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10986.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
