Authorize a competitive solicitation and contract with the lowest responsible bidder for construction of the Downtown-Old Town: Caruthers-Mill Sewer Rehabilitation Project No. E10986 in the amount of \$3,296,200 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) needs to rehabilitate 7,300 feet of sanitary sewer pipe primarily in the Portland State University area that is in severely deteriorated condition.
- 2. Environmental Services has prepared plans and specifications for rehabilitating the deteriorated sewer pipe, including manholes and service laterals.
- 3. The engineer's estimate for the contract action is \$3,296,200. The level of confidence is high. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2018-19 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, WBS Element E10986.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending a. the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
