### Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

Oregon State Police (OSP) will allow the City of Portland Police Bureau's Forensic Evidence Division access to OSP's Automated Biometric Identification System (ABIS).

### Financial and budgetary impacts:

The maximum not-to-exceed compensation payable to OSP by the City under this 5-year Intergovernmental Agreement is \$102,480.
