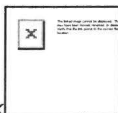

Subject: I request to testify on August 15th at City Council

I read 84% of police officers have stated in a recent survey that they have directly witnessed a fellow officer using more force than was necessary. (US Department of Justice) and I witnessed that first hand when I attend a counterprotest on September, 4th, 2018. I am deeply concerned about the weapons used to our citizens, like stinger grenades, cs gas, and tear gas, saber red gas, and kinetic impact projectiles also known as rubber bullets. I feel that our city need to protect its citizens as well as our First Amendment right to freedom of speech and assembly. I feel that the militarized techniques the Portland Police Department exhibits are too extreme. I believe the police department should be trained not only how to use the equipment of crowd disbursement, but more importantly how to de-escalate the situation. I have firsthand account with videotape and with my presence at the counterprotest. I can testify firsthand in regards to the and brutal actions the police officers exhibited on September 4, 2018. More specifically I would like an investigation with Officer Madison, Officer Caler, and Officer Flippo and their actions at the counterprotest.


