

# ORDINANCE No. 189164

\*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for the City to provide quick copy work and printing services (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. City of Portland Printing and Distribution Division provides quick copy work and printing services to all City bureaus, Portland area agencies of the State of Oregon, and other local governmental agencies.
2. Multnomah County, Purchasing Section, has determined the City to be the best choice available based upon price and service.
3. The City has the physical capacity to absorb anticipated volumes so that there will be no negative impact on the City service levels.
4. The additional volume generated under the attached Intergovernmental Agreement will help utilize equipment more efficiently and allow the City to continue investing in the newest, most technologically advanced equipment.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council Directs:


- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement, substantially in conformance with the attached Exhibit A, with Multnomah County for printing services for all County agencies.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay will adversely affect the business relationship that has developed between Multnomah County and the City of Portland. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
