Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

In 2001, the City of Portland granted a franchise to Portland General Distribution LLC, doing business as Portland General Broadband ("Portland General Broadband"), to construct, operate, and maintain a telecommunications system with all necessary facilities, in the city's streets. In 2004, OnFiber Communications, Inc. became a successor to Portland General Broadband. City staff is currently negotiating a renewal franchise with OnFiber Communications, Inc. City staff recommends that the Council extend the existing franchise through August 31, 2019 to allow parties time to complete negotiations and to complete the formal franchising process required by the Portland City Charter.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

The City will continue to receive franchise fees for use of the right of way from OnFiber Communications, Inc. for approximately \$21,000 per year
