

ORDINANCE NO. 6524

An Ordinance granting to the Chinese the privilege of celebrating their New Years Festivities.

The City of Portland does ordain as follows;

Section 1;- That permission is hereby granted to the Chinese residents of the City of Portland to explode fire-crackers within the City limits from the 7th day of February 1891, to the 17th day of February 1891, inclusive, except on Sundays, between the hours of 5 and 7 o'clock A.M. and 6 and 9 o'clock P.M. of each day, Provided that nothing herein contained shall authorize the exploding of fire-crackers at any time on the first day of the week, commonly called Sunday.

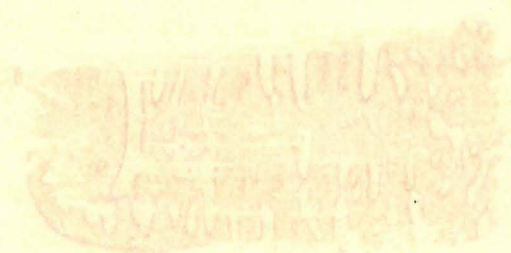
