ORDINANCE No. 189177

* Pay property damage and bodily injury claims of Tara Karki in the sum of \$30,210 involving Portland Bureau of Transportation (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Tara Karki, through attorney Willard Merkel, has filed property damage and bodily injury claims against the City for damages suffered in a Streetcar collision involving the Portland Bureau of Transportation on Sunday, October 29, 2017.
- 2. The claims have been investigated by Risk Management Services. The investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid litigation expenses and the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise these claims at this time.
- 3. Risk Management Services recommends these claims be compromised for the total sum of \$30,210.42, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver two checks as follows:
 - 1) one check in the amount of \$12,500 made payable to Tara Karki and Merkel & Associates, and
 - 2) one check in the amount of \$17,710.42 made payable to GEICO Casualty Insurance Co.
- b. Risk Management Services will execute payment authorizations in the amounts set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling these property damage and bodily injury claims; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.


