

Whereas several contractors with the city, ~~have~~ in violation of the laws of the state, the resolutions of the Council and of their written contracts entered into with the city of Portland, have employed Chinese laborers upon the public streets to the serious detriment of the white laboring class of citizens of Portland.

Resolved, that it is the sense of the Council that all persons who shall hereafter violate their contracts by employing Chinamen upon the public streets be declared delinquent and refused further contracts from the city.
