

ORDINANCE No. 189186

*Authorize a grant agreement with Latino Network in an amount not to exceed \$44,737 for making open and accountable elections work for all Portlanders. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Latino Network will serve as the fiscal agent for this grant that was originally awarded to Amplify NW now called Oregon Futures Lab.
2. Open and accountable elections is a worthy and needed program, offering an alternative path to run for elected office in Portland. It offers the opportunity to expand the pool of those who run and those who support them. The goal of this program is to build a program where participants (donors and potential candidates) reflect Portland's diversity.
3. The efficacy of using this program will not be measured simply through compliance. It will be measured through its ability to gather participation from underrepresented voices; whether they be donors, volunteers, or candidates. Participation by these voices requires trust. To build that trust requires working with the community-based organizations that reflect those voices, the organizations who are the trusted messengers—and the trusted experts—in the very communities who are under-represented. This project will primarily benefit culturally-specific organizations and the communities they serve, as well as potential candidates, volunteers and donors of color who are interested in using the Open & Accountable Elections program.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement, with Latino Network as outlined in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed \$44,737.
- b. The Director of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver payment chargeable to Fiscal Year 2018-2019 Budget.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in funding could result in a delay in services; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by Council.
