Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Experience PDX project is an opportunity for the City of Portland to invest in an established, cost effective and scalable model that engages Older Adults (50+) in vital civic work to support Portland youth in reading at grade level by the end of third grade, and support the health and well-being of those who volunteer in this effort.

Leveraging the evidence-based and successful AARP Experience Corps model, the project connects the City of Portland's vision for educational equity in Portland with two major initiatives in asset-based aging:

- Portland's Age Friendly City initiative that aims to build a community for all ages offers the opportunity to promote diversity and equity while strengthening inclusion of all ages and residents as assets in our community.
- Generations to Generations Campaign (<u>Encore.org</u> project to mobilize 1 million adults age 50+ in US to help children thrive) (led in Portland by MFS and Bridge Meadows).

Financial and budgetary impacts:

Funding for this grant is available in the FY2018-19 budget in the General Fund Special Appropriations. There is no new financial impact.

Community impacts and community involvement:

MFS will be engaging a broad consortium of partners who support youth success and value the experience and contributions of older adults. The second year of the project will focus on generating recommendations and elevating culturally responsive best practices to the national AARP Foundation Experience Corps network.

MFS will provide community engagement activities in collaboration with IRCO and other culturally specific partners at target sites to build connection between schools and communities.
