

## ORDINANCE No. 189190

\*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the East Portland Active Transportation to Transit Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. In January 2013, City Council executed an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for the East Portland Active Transportation to Transit Project via Ordinance No. 185841; and
2. In September 2015, City Council executed an Intergovernmental Agreement for Right of Way Services with the Oregon Department of Transportation for temporary construction easements related to construction.
3. The East Portland Active Transportation to Transit Project will provide sidewalk infill and pedestrian crossing improvements on SE Division and install the 130's Neighborhood Greenway between the Springwater Corridor Trail and the I-84 Multi-Use Path.
4. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 2018/19 and proposed FY 2019/20 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is moderate; the project is well defined, and the project plans and special provisions are finalized.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Office is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00383 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the project must be bid by September 30, 2018 to meet federal funding guidelines; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
