## **ORDINANCE No.** 189193

Authorize sale of usable surplus Mobile Data Computers pursuant to City Code 5.36 for approximately \$12,250 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau is replacing all of the Mobile Data Computers (MDCs) that are installed in its vehicles because they have reached the end of their useful lives.
- Criminal Justice Information System (CJIS) standards set by the Federal Bureau of Investigation require two-factor authentication for secure logon to the bureau's MDCs.
- 3. The old MDCs required an added piece of hardware, the POSH MX5-K9 units, to provide two-factor authentication for CJIS compliance.
- 4. The MDC replacement project has selected new MDCs that include built-in two-factor authentication, making the POSH MX5-K9 hardware obsolete.
- 5. POSH MFG USA, LLC (POSH), the manufacturer of the MX5-K9 units, is willing to buy back the bureau's inventory, which would benefit the City financially and minimize waste and pollution.
- 6. The Bureau of Technology Services (BTS) has determined that the most efficient and cost-effective option for disposal of this usable surplus technical equipment is through the sell-back to POSH of these units.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Chief Procurement Officer is hereby authorized to sell the obsolete MX5-K9 units owned by the Police Bureau to POSH MFG USA, LLC.
