ORDINANCE NO.

*Authorize application to Bloomberg Philanthropies for the American Cities Climate Challenge for technical assistance and a support package valued at approximately \$2 million to support City progress toward achieving the goals of the Climate Action Plan (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland's 2015 Climate Action Plan adopted goals and actions focused on reducing carbon emissions by 80 percent by 2050, and 40 percent by 2030 (Resolution 37135).
- 2. Reaching these emission reduction goals requires bold vision and aggressive action. The American Cities Climate Challenge provides an opportunity access resources, support and technical assistance to advance key actions in the buildings and transportation sectors.
- 3. The application process consists of a pre-proposal application (due July 18, 2018) seeking an invitation to submit a final proposal later in the summer of 2018. 20 cities will be selected for award from the final proposals.
- 4. There is no local match requested in the proposal phase of the process, and any future match, if required, is expected to be in the form of salary, benefits, and materials and services in the FY 2018/19 and FY 2019/20 budgets of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability and Portland Bureau of Transportation.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to Bloomberg Philanthropies for the American Cities Climate Challenge as outlined in application for (Exhibit A).
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Management Division is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists so that the City can meet the timelines in the grant. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
