

AMENDMENT NUMBER 1
CONTRACT NUMBER 30003584
FOR
Crisis Intervention Program

Pursuant to Ordinance Number

This Amendment, made and entered by and between Trauma Intervention Programs Portland/Vancouver Inc., ("Consultant"), and the City of Portland, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, by and through its duly authorized representatives ("City"), is effective as of December 1, 2018.

RECITALS:

1. The original contract expires November 30, 2018. This Amendment extends the term of the Contract through November 30, 2023.
2. Additional work is necessary as described in the Scope of Work as follows: Consultant will provide an additional five years of emotional crisis intervention services.
3. Additional compensation is necessary for the additional work, but shall not exceed \$414,033.44 for the five-year term of the extension. The compensation per year shall be as follows:

This extension cap of \$414,033.44 added to the original Contract cap of \$390,0000 creates an overall Contract cap amount of \$804,033.44.

4. The PAYMENT TERMS stated on Page 6 of the original Contract is amended to delete the payment amount of \$6,500 per month and replace it with the following:
"Consultant will submit an invoice for no more than 1/12th of the annual fee per month."
5. The PAYMENT TERMS stated on Page 6 of the original Contract is amended to delete the Hourly Rates per person and replace it with the following table:

6. All other terms and conditions of the original Contract shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.

Therefore, the Parties agree as follows:

1. The Recitals above are true and correct and are part of this Amendment No. 1.
2. The Parties agree to be bound by the terms of the original Contract, as amended herein.

This Contract amendment may be signed in two (2) or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original, and which, when taken together, shall constitute one and the same Contract amendment.

The parties agree the City and Consultant may conduct this transaction by electronic means, including the use of electronic signatures.
