**Legislation title:** \*Amend contract with Trauma Intervention Programs Portland/Vancouver Inc. in the amount of \$414,033.44 to provide emergency emotional crisis intervention services for an additional five years. (Ordinance: amend Contract No. 30003584)

**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

The purpose of this legislation is for City Council to authorize an amendment with Trauma Intervention Programs Portland/Vancouver Inc. (TIP) in the amount of \$414,033.44 for an additional five years of services. TIP performs emergency emotional crisis intervention services to victims, family members, and bystanders involved in emergency medical response incidents.

Providing immediate on-scene crisis services to emotionally traumatized persons is sensitive work and requires the use of an organization with the highest quality standards and proven track record. TIP is a nationally recognized leader in providing volunteer emergency support services.

In accordance with PCC 5.68.035(B), Council approval is required to authorize a PTE contract amendment when the amendment would exceed 25 percent of the original contract amount.

**Financial and budgetary impacts:**

Through this agreement, Portland Fire & Rescue agrees to compensate TIP a not-to-exceed amount of \$414,033.44 for the five-year term of the extension. The expense is included in PF&R's budget beginning FY 2018-19.
