

# ORDINANCE No. 189208

Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with the State of Oregon in the amount of \$300,158 for the design and construction of certain improvements on Glisan St as part of the Fixing Our Streets program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. By the authority granted in Oregon Revised Statute (ORS) 190.110, state agencies may enter into agreements with units of local government for the performance of any or all functions and activities that a party to the agreement, its officers, or agents have the authority to perform.
2. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) desires that State, acting by and through its Department of Transportation (ODOT), designs and constructs certain improvements on Glisan Street from approximately the Interstate 205 northbound on and off ramps to NE 99th Avenue (the "Project"). The completed Project will be a part of PBOT's "Fixing Our Streets" program and will create safer roads and crossings for cyclists and pedestrians using the City's street system.
3. Glisan Street west of 97th Avenue is a part of the state highway system under the jurisdiction and control of the Oregon Transportation Commission (OTC). 97th Avenue and Glisan Street east of 97th Avenue are parts of the City's street system under the jurisdiction and control of PBOT.
4. ODOT is currently engaged in the "I-205: Johnson Creek Boulevard to Glenn Jackson Bridge" project. ODOT is willing to incorporate this Project into its I-205 Project provided that State receives payment from PBOT in the amount agreed upon.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the State of Oregon in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A, at a cost not to exceed, \$300,158.
