

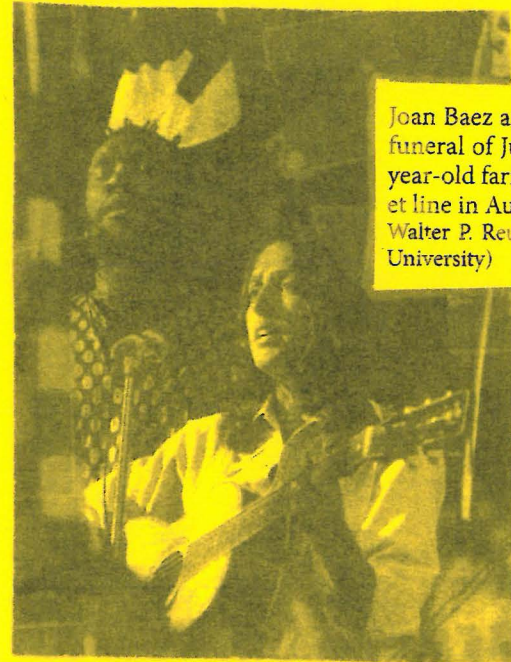
THE AGING NOT-SO-WELL UNDER TRUMP

CONFERENCE

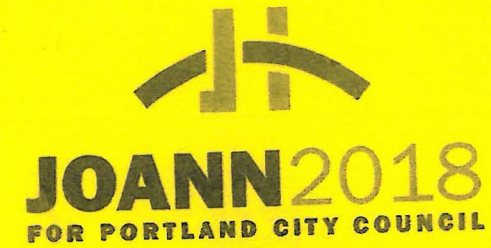
When: Saturday, 12 noon-3pm, Oct. 27th, 2018

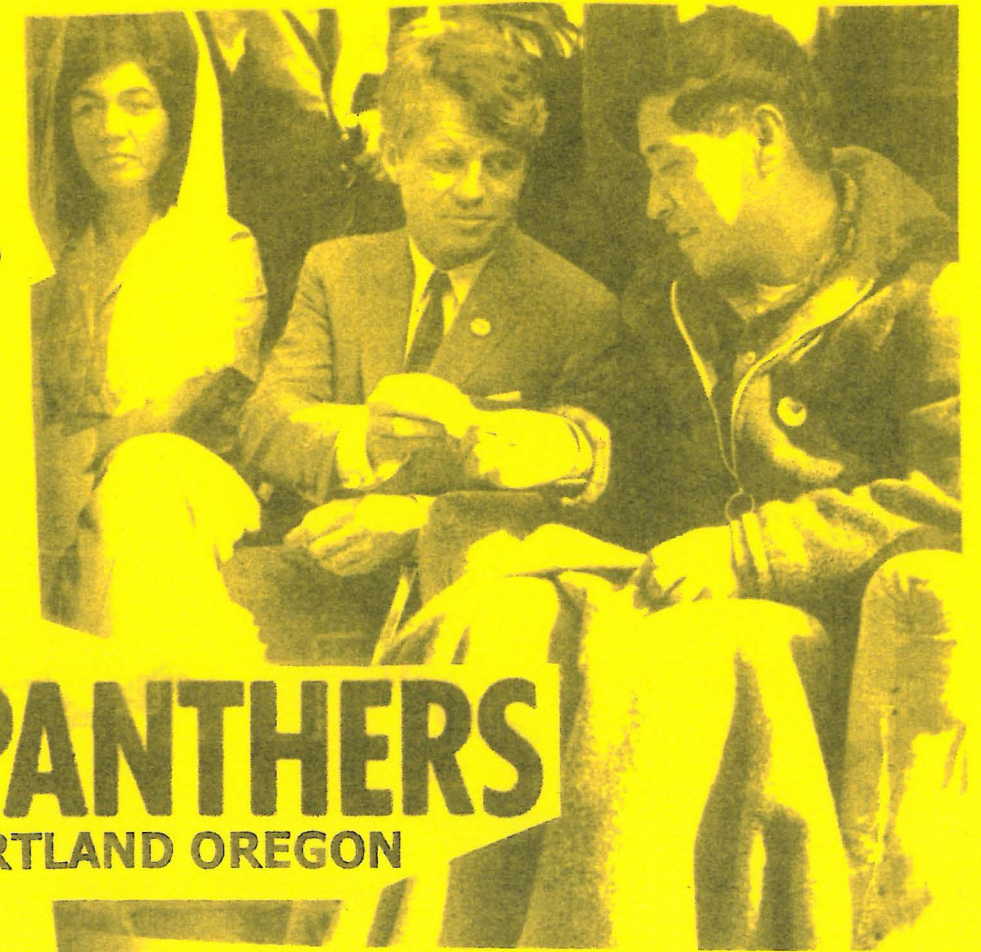

****RENT CONTROL and DISARM PSU are two current Panther projects in our region. JoAnn Hardesty for City Council, for example, supports rent control in Oregon—the opposition candidate just took \$2,500 from the landlord coalition (Metro Family Housing Assoc.). DISARM PSU has three demands: (1) fire the campus police worker who shot 17 times with a co-worker [who has already left PSU!], 9 bullets hitting and killing Jason, a grandfather; (2) disarm campus police at PSU; and (3) erect a permanent memorial at PSU for Jason.**
