ORDINANCE No. 189224

Authorize a Memorandum of Understanding with the partner agencies that constitute the Domestic Violence Enhanced Response Team for the stated project goals listed in the Office on Violence Against Women FY 2017-2020 Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders grant program application and award (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Police Bureau has been an active member of the Multnomah County Family Violence Coordinating Council since 1999, with participating members active in the current version of the Domestic Violence Enhanced Response Team (DVERT) since its creation in 2006;
- Partner agencies collaborated on the Department of Justice (DOJ) Office on Violence Against Women (OVW) FY17 Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders (GTEAP) grant application. The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) was an application requirement of the solicitation;
- 3. The FY17 GTEAP grant period is from October 1, 2017, through September 30, 2020; and
- 4. The Memorandum of Understanding establishes a set of aspirations and goals among the partners. It is not legally enforceable and shall not be construed to create any legal obligation on the part of any party. It shall not be construed to create a private right, benefit, or cause of action for or by any person enforceable at law or equity against any partner, their officers, employees, or any other person.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to execute an MOU in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
