## ORDINANCE NO. 189256

Update Water Code to replace gender-specific language (Ordinance; amend Title 21)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- In December 2015, City Council passed Resolution No. 37175 that directed, in part, the Office of the City Attorney and Bureau of Human Resources to work with all City bureaus to examine their policies and procedures, including but not limited to policy documents, rules and regulations, applications, permits, and contracts, to assess whether gender-specific language in the documents should be eliminated and replaced with gender-neutral language.
- 2. It is important the City Water Code be updated as applicable regulations change. This legislation will authorize the amendment to City Water Code, Title 21, to replace gender-specific language.
- Updating City Water Code with these amendments will promote a welcoming and inclusive environment by adopting the use of gender-neutral language in the City Water Code wherever applicable and allows the Water Bureau to comply with Resolution No. 37175.
- 4. Per Portland City Code Title 3, the Portland Water Bureau administers and enforces Portland City Title 21 Water.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. Portland City Title 21 Water is amended as shown in the attached Exhibit A.
