ORDINANCE NO. 189257

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsive bidder and provide payment for the construction of the Road 10R MP 28.77 – 31.85 Project in the Bull Run watershed at an estimated cost of \$1,540,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Water Bureau requires the rehabilitation and improvement of Road 10R between mile post 28.77 and mile post 31.85 which is the main road to the Bull Run Watershed facilities.
- 2. This segment of Road 10 has a low end of fair condition rating which puts the road beyond the effectiveness of preventive maintenance techniques, thus requiring reconstruction.
- 3. It is anticipated that the Road 10R MP 28.77 31.85 Project (Project) will be constructed in the summer/fall of 2019.
- 4. Funding is available in the FY 2018-19 Budget and will be requested in the FY 2019-20 Budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Water Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
