ORDINANCE No. 189258

*Create a new represented classification of Electronics Technician, Assistant and establish an interim compensation rate for this classification. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. In accordance with the policies established by the City Council and based on a classification and compensation review, the Bureau of Human Resources is creating a new represented classification effective November 28, 2018.
- 2. The business needs that this classification is intended to meet cannot be fulfilled until the classification and wage rate is established; however, the wage rate for the classification must be collectively bargained with IBEW Local 48. Under Article 27.5.2 of the DCTU contract, the City may establish interim rates during bargaining.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The following classification is being created:

b. The following interim compensation rate is established:

c. When the City and IBEW Local 48 conclude necessary bargaining over the appropriate salary rates, the rates may be implemented with no further action upon signing of a Memorandum of Agreement between the Director of Human Resources and IBEW Local 48 and approval as to form by the Office of the City Attorney.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists in order that this classification and compensation action may occur without delay; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
