Legislation title: *Create a new represented classification of Electronics Technician, Assistant and establish an interim compensation rate for this classification. (Ordinance)

Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

The Bureau of Technology Services (BTS) requested the creation of a represented classification in order to classify entry-level work to assist with the installation, testing, repair and removal of electronic equipment and communication devices. The Bureau of Human Resources (BHR) worked with BTS to develop the Electronics Technician, Assistant classification. This classification should be effective November 28, 2018. The Electronics Technician, Assistant classification will be represented by IBEW Local 48.

Financial and budgetary impacts:

There is no direct cost to create the new classification; BTS intends to create a new 24-month limited-term position. FY 18-19 will include the first seven months of the position and cost \$26,200. The cost for FY 19-20 will be \$37,440.

Community impacts and community involvement:

This action is largely internal to City government processes.
