

ORDINANCE No. 189270

* Amend the Amended and Restated Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for Funding of the Sellwood Bridge Project to better align City payments to the project completion timeline (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 33000048)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The original *Intergovernmental Agreement for the Funding of the Sellwood Bridge Project* was entered into by the City of Portland and Multnomah County (Parties) effective February 25, 2011.
2. The *Amended and Restated Intergovernmental Agreement for the Funding of the Sellwood Bridge Project* was entered into by Parties effective February 18, 2015.
3. *Amendment #1 to the Amended and Restated Intergovernmental Agreement for the Funding of the Sellwood Bridge Project* was entered into by Parties effective February 18, 2015.
4. The Parties desire to amend the Agreement to better align the County's receipt of City funding to the currently expected Project completion timeline.

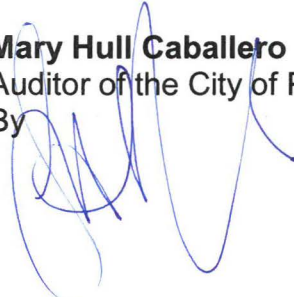
NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Mayor and the City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into Amendment #2 to the Amended and Restated Intergovernmental Agreement, Contract No. 33000048 with Multnomah County for Funding of the Sellwood Bridge Project, in a form similar to contract attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the agreement; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
