## ORDINANCE No. 189281

Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Metro for a total amount of \$828,523 for the Annual Waste Reduction Program, the Recycle at Work Program and the Business Food Waste Program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Metro has notified the City of Portland Bureau of Planning and Sustainability that it will award \$828,523.09 in FY 18-19. The specific areas of funding are intended to support the Metro Annual Waste Reduction for \$325,405.20, Recycle at Work Program for \$405,163.89, and Business Food Waste Program for \$97,954.00.
- 2. Metro funds continue to support mutual regional and citywide goals for improved efforts in waste reduction, recycling, and composting programs.
- 3. No City match is required.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland funding from Metro in the amount of \$828,523.09 and to execute an agreement with Metro, substantially similar to Attachment 1.
- b. Part of the funding in the amount of \$785,604 was appropriated in the FY 2018-19 Adopted Budget for the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability. The remaining funds of \$42,919.09 will be appropriated in Spring BMP 2019.
- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Metro for Contract No. 30006590, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.
