ORDINANCE No. 189293

Update Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Code, add definitions and align terminology with Metro (Ordinance; amend Code Chapter 17.102)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- The Solid Waste and Recycling Collection Code is located in Portland City Code (PCC) 17.102 and housekeeping edits are required to update the code and align terminology with Portland's local government partners.
- 2. PCC 17.102.010 Declaration of Policy. This section removes obsolete figures and adds service standards for commercial customers.
- 3. PCC 17.102.020 Definitions. Expanding the definition of Biodiesel allows the use of renewable diesel to meet clean and efficient fleet requirements. Streamlining clean and efficient fleet practices requires a new definition for collection vehicles that includes both residential and commercial vehicles. Commercial compostables terminology is amended to align with Metro Regional Government's terminology.
- 4. PCC 17.102.050 Clean and Efficient Fleet Practices for Franchisees and Permittees. Both residential and commercial clean fleet requirements have been substantially implemented. Federal emissions standards have resulted in cleaner trucks manufactured beginning in 2010 and the Climate Action Plan has identified garbage and recycling collection vehicle emissions as a target for reduction.
- 5. PCC 17.102 Right of Appeal and Payment of Assessments. Appeal fees are no longer applied; this amendment deletes references to the appeal payment.
- 6. PCC 17.102.270 Businesses and Multifamily Complexes Required to Recycle. Existing references to commercial compostables collection are inconsistent with Metro Regional Government.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. Amend PCC Chapter 17.102 Solid Waste and Recycling Collection, according to Exhibit A.
