## Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

Portland City Code 17.102 Solid Waste and Recycling Collection is recommended to be amended to remove obsolete information, align with Metro Regional Government Administrative Rules, update clean fleet requirements and remove appeals fees.

#### Financial and budgetary impacts:

Proposed amendments to PCC Chapter 17.102 do not have any financial or budgetary impacts on the Bureau of Planning and Sustainability.

#### Community impacts and community involvement:

Portland residents and visitors will benefit from continued air quality improvements, resulting in a City with higher standards for human health.
